I am happy to inform my collaborators that - after many comings and goings - I have received the Blessing from Pope Francis. What am I talking about? Let me explain!

As you know, my poem "Dreams of a Deafblind Man" has won over the world through more than 15 languages in which it has been translated. I envisioned, then, seeking to have Pope Francis' blessing the poem. And so I went in search of "connections' to achieve this, knowing that the Pope, besides being the Head of the Catholic Church, is a Head of State, and, thus, it is ultra complicated to make something get to him. Even knowing this, my development stated: Always try!

First action: "Digging" addresses that could be more or less effective for my objective. I managed to get two addresses through collaborators who live in Italy.

Second action: I sent by mail - with the support of a collaborator - two letters. One to each address.
